

Queen Elizabeth® - Deployment Overview

Icy glaciers at the edge of civilization, cities steeped in tradition, and golden beaches swathed in sunshine are the cornerstone of 2023 Queen Elizabeth® voyages. Calling at 41 ports in 15 countries, she'll embark on coastal explorations of Japan and Alaska, offering glacier cruising alongside calls to Skagway, Sitka and Ketchikan. The star-studded streets of Los Angeles, Mexico's Cabo San Lucas and a full transit of the Panama Canal are next, before a 6-week cruise season exploring the Mediterranean, where Ibiza, Palma de Mallorca, and Ajaccio (birthplace of Napoleon) are among the captivating ports of call.



Admire one of Japan's best-preserved feudal castles, Kochi-Jo, on a port call to Kochi, and see the poignant structure of the Genbaku Dome at Hiroshima's UNESCO-listed Peace Memorial Park.

The Baltics

From the majestic presence of Russia's former capital, St Petersburg, to the leafy boulevards and Dutch-style canals of Gothenburg in Sweden, a Baltics voyage offers chance to step ashore in some of the world's most culturally significant and atmospheric cities. The sensory discovery continues in Stornoway, where a walk around Lews Castle Grounds unveils spectacular scenes of babbling brooks, emerald vegetation and piercing blue sea, while Edinburgh (tours from New Haven) provides a gateway to the city's ancient castle, the Royal Mile and Arthur's Seat.

Atlantic Coast & Iberia



Offering sunshine and warmth throughout the year, a voyage of the Atlantic Coast and Iberia is the perfect way to reinvigorate when the temperatures drop elsewhere. Lay back on golden sands in secluded coves, wander pretty harbors fringed by fishing boats, and feast on seafood plucked fresh from the ocean just hours before. On the Spanish coast, Cadiz charms with its old town filled with watchtowers, while the Portuguese city of Lisbon is your gateway to the UNESCO-listed palaces of Sintra. Admire the craftmanship of centuries old cathedrals in Las Palmas and Funchal, swim in the gentle swell of crystal clear seas in Fuerteventura, and drink in the history at the 18th century fortress of San Jose Castle in Lanzarote.

North Cape

A voyage to the North Cape offers a journey to the furthest reaches of civilization, where buildings, cars and people are outweighed by mountains, forests and sea. Sailing at the peak of the midnight sun, you'll experience a land where darkness never falls, and the orange glow of the sun is always visible above the horizon. It's the perfect setting in which to explore the otherworldly landscapes of fjords, waterfalls and houses clinging to barren rock faces, the magnitude of which defies imagination. Step ashore among the stilted wooden buildings of the Lofoten Islands, cross the Gamle Bybro bridge to Trondheim's Old Town, admire the stained-glass windows of Tromso's Arctic Cathedral, and enjoy time exploring in the North Cape's capital, Honningsvaag.

Iceland

With a landscape defined by geysers, volcanoes, and glaciers, a journey to Iceland unlocks scenery and experiences unlike anywhere else on earth. Magical and otherworldly, it's not difficult to see why so many travelers fall under its spell. The towns and cities you'll encounter on a voyage here hold equal appeal, with museums displaying contemporary art and exhibits charting Iceland's Viking ancestry. An overnight in the capital, Reykjavík, offers opportunity to visit the Blue Lagoon or embark on a circuit of the Golden Circle, while calls to Akureyri and Isafjordur introduce historic wooden houses and the soul-stirring landscapes of the Westfjords and Eyjafjörður Fjord.

Northern Lights

Timed to offer the greatest possibility of sighting the colorful phenomenon, the aurora borealis, a Northern Lights voyage couples port calls in Norway's characterful fjord towns with evenings on deck, in hopeful anticipation of witnessing nature's night-time light show.
